It contains millions of specialized photoreceptor cells called rods and cones that convert light rays into electrical signals that are transmitted to the brain through the optic nerve.

Vitreous surgery is a type of operation which allows eye surgeons to treat patients with diseases of the retina. Also called vitrectomy, it is the surgical removal of the vitreous gel from the middle of the eye.

Vitrectomy is a type of eye surgery used to treat problems of the eye's retina and vitreous. In this surgery, an ophthalmologist may: remove blood or other substance keeping light from focusing properly on the retina remove scar tissue that is wrinkling or tearing the retina and causing poor vision

A vitrectomy, sometimes called vitreous surgery, refers to the removal of the vitreous gel from the eye. This procedure is performed in a hospital operating room, using an operating microscope. There are several retinal disorders for which vitrectomy surgery may be the appropriate treatment.
