The Need for Pretend Play in Child Development ...
Pretend play has also been correlated with two crucial skill sets--the ability to self-regulate (impulses, emotions, attention) and the ability to reason counterfactually. In the first case, studies report that kids who engage in frequent, pretend play have stronger self-regulation skills.

The cognitive benefits of play: Effects on the learning brain
The manner by which pretend play contributes to children ' s cognitive development has gained increasing interest recently. Play provides children with opportunities to develop their cognitive skills and make connections between different areas of activities and experiences (Wood, 2008).

Studies show that the importance of pretend play in child development extends beyond simply language development. Smith and Simon (1984) found that play can enhance children ' s creativity and problem solving skills.
